STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Bylaws excerpt:
Article IV
Sec. 4

To qualify as eligible for the office of Director a person:

- a) shall be a member in good standing of the CFC;
- b) shall be cognizant to CFC history, Statement of Purpose, Bylaws, and methods of operation, BOD duties and responsibilities as stated in the BOD manual;
- c) shall be committed to serving a thirty-six month term;
- d) shall not be the General Manager of the CFC; and
- e) with the exception of any one (1) Director that may be a member of the CFC staff, a Director shall not be employed by the CFC.
